The City is trying to get all debris picked up. Please make sure you keep tree debris away from other items. All construction debris and furniture items have to be kept in separate piles.

Please follow the trash rules. It leaves a mess on the grounds when items get left out for days before pick up. You must call the City for a bulk pick up and don't put the items out until they say that they are picking up. Don't put plastic bags in the blue lid container with cans.

Break down cardboard boxes and put in the brown lid container. All other items go into black lid containers.

GUTTERS

There are units which have gutters full of leaves & other debris. This could cause a leak not to mention that some have weeds growing in gutters.
